Title:	Fundraising Research Intern
Reporting to:	Fundraising Manager
Commitment:	Part-time, flexible hours, 20-25 hours per week, office-based
Duration:	Six to nine months (starting in August/September 2017)
Expenses:	The position is an unpaid internship. PRI will reimburse travel within London zones and lunch expenses, on production of receipts according to the volunteer expenses policy.

Tasks include:

Fundraising

- Conducting desk-based research and analysis on potential funders
- Conducting 'other player analysis', scoping and market research
- Ad hoc research and evidence collation as required for proposals and reports
- Assisting the Fundraising Manager with the administration of submissions and reports for upcoming or existing proposals
- Assisting with the drafting of proposals

Administrative

- Maintaining PRI's database of funders and supporting with the migration of contacts to a new system
- Other reasonable tasks as assigned
