Questions concerning Violent Extremism and Radicalization that Lead to Terrorism (VERLT) in the prison context have received increasing attention at the OSCE and at the international level more generally, including through decisions such as the 2015 Belgrade Declaration on preventing and countering VERLT of the OSCE Ministerial Council and resolutions of the Human Rights Council.

This side-event will explore and promote exchange of information on human rights issues arising in countering and preventing terrorist radicalisation in prisons: encompassing both overall prison conditions and the need for human-rights based approaches to the management of violent extremist offenders and their rehabilitation and reintegration.
