Oberstown is developing a reporting tool that will help better understand violent incidents impacting children in child detention facilities, in collaboration with international NGOs.

This reporting tool is implemented in two other facilities in Bulgaria and Romania, and it will be introduced to other European countries in a couple of months, to make European child detention facilities safer for children!

There have been minor changes in the CMS system to achieve this.

What is Data MOSAIC reporting?

What to do?

Are you reporting

- a fight between YP or a YP and staff?
- a severe or a minor aggression?

It could be

- pushing or tripping,
- a shoulder checking, or even
- throwing an object.

Please make sure to check with the YP subjected to this treatment and if there is harm on that end:

Please report it to the Incident Tab.

Have you witnessed or learned about

- name-calling, taunting or threatening by another YP or a staff
- yelling, belittling, insulting or intentionally excluding or humiliating a YP?

Or the other way around,

- staff favouring one or more YP compared to others?

Please make sure to check with the YP subjected to this treatment and if there is harm on that end:

Please report the incident to Care Day Report or Care Night Report.

Did you hear or witnessed a YP or a staff

- making sexualised comments or inappropriate comments to a YP

It could also be

- grooming or
- any other behaviour that sexualises the YP

In any case

Please report the incident to Care Day Report or Care Night Report .
